
## Private Harry Williams 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion, Kings Shropshire Light Infantry

- He was born about 1892 at Newtown, Wem, the son of Richard and Hannah.
- In 1911 he was living with his parents at Ash House, Ash and working on his father's farm as a waggoner.
- He married Sarah A. Dodd between January and March 1916 and they had a son, Harry G who was born between
   July and August of that year.
- He enlisted at Whitchurch (date NK), & was killed in Action on 2 April 1917
- He is buried in Fauburg D'Amiens Cemetery, Arras & remembered on Ash War Memorial.
- He was awarded the British War and Victory Medals.
- His widow was granted a War Gratuity of £3/10/-d and the sum of £2/6/7d from his pay account was refunded to "Widow Sarah and child".
