Private William Graydon 2nd Battalion, Grenadier Guards

- He was born in January 1888 at Lisnaskea, Co. Fermanagh, son of Joseph and Catherine.
- The family came to live at No 28 Ash Parva between 1894 and 1897
- In 1911 he was living at home and working as a general agricultural labourer.
- He entered France in 1916 and was posted 'missing since 25 September 1916, death presumed'
- He is remembered on the Thiepval Memorial, France and Ash War memorial.
- He was awarded the British War Medal and the Victory Medal.
- His widowed mother was granted a War Gratuity of £3/-/-d and refunded £1/16/10d from his pay account.
 The balance of £1/5/8d was divided between his brothers, John and Samuel.
