- He was born between January and March 1893, the son of Joseph and Sarah Jane nee Slinn at Whixall.
- In 1911 he was living with his parent at Jessima Cottage, New Woodhouses, working as a Grocer's Assistant.
- He died of wounds "in the field" on 4th February 1917 and was buried in Philosophie British Cemetery, Mazingaee.
 - He was awarded the British War Medal and the Victory Medal.
 - His father was granted a War Gratuity of £3/10/-d. and the sum of £8/12/7d. in his pay account refunded.
