



## Private John Joseph Faulkner 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion North Staffordshire Regiment

- He was born between January and March 1893, the son of Joseph and Sarah Jane nee Slinn at Whixall.
- In 1911 he was living with his parent at Jessima Cottage, New Woodhouses, working as a Grocer's Assistant.
- He died of wounds "in the field" on 4<sup>th</sup> February 1917 and was buried in Philosophie British Cemetery, Mazingae.
- He was awarded the British War Medal and the Victory Medal.
- His father was granted a War Gratuity of £3/10/-d. and the sum of £8/12/7d. in his pay account refunded.
