This play area is open for the purpose of individual outdoor exercise subject to the current Coronavirus Regulations which still requires everyone to follow the social distancing rules and restricts public gatherings. You should restrict social interactions to members of your household*.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. You may enter this facility individually or as a household*
- 2. If you are alone you may enter this facility with ONE other person not in your household
- 3. Members of a household group should not mix with any other household group on the Recreation Ground.
- 4. We ask that use of each item of equipment within the play area is limited to one household* at one time and, if possible, wipe clean surfaces that you have touched before moving to the next item of equipment
- 5. EVERYONE not in the same household* must comply with the social distancing rules by keeping two metres apart
- 6. You should **not** use this facility if you are showing coronavirus symptoms, have been in contact with someone showing symptoms in the last 48 hours, or if you or a member of your household* is self-isolating.
- 7. Please use the hand sanitizer when entering this facility
- 8. For your own safety avoid touching your face/mouth/eyes
- 9. For the benefit of and respect for others, please leave this facility in a clean and tidy condition and, if possible, wipe clean surfaces that you have touched before you leave
- 10. We ask that you refrain from bringing pets/animals into the Play Ground
- 11. Please ensure the gate is properly closed when you leave
- 12. For your own safety please wash your hands and equipment when you return to your vehicle and when you get home
