- He was born between January and March 1897, the son of Thomas and Esther Elizabeth at Ash.
- In 1911 he was living with his parents at no. 19, Church Lane, Ash Magna and was working as a domestic gardener.
- He enlisted at Whitchurch.
- He was killed in action at Arras on 27 April 1917 and is remembered upon Arras Memorial, France and Ash War Memorial.
- He was awarded the British War and Victory Medals.
- His mother as sole legatee was granted a War Gratuity of £3/10/-d. and refunded the sum of £2/7/8d. in his pay account.
