

Welcome to The Bradbury

This tennis court is open for the purpose of individual outdoor exercise subject to the current Coronavirus Regulations which still requires everyone to follow the social distancing rules and restricts public gatherings. You should restrict social interactions to members of no more than two households* or to a group of no more than 6 persons from different households while practising social distancing

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

1. One person may enter this facility to play with **no more than five** other people where this includes persons outside of your household*, or
2. You may enter this facility as a group with more than six people PROVIDED everyone in the group is also a member from not more than two households *.
3. Members of a group should not mix with any other group on the tennis court
4. EVERYONE not in the same household* must comply with the social distancing rules by keeping two metres apart
5. You should not use this facility if you are showing coronavirus symptoms, have been in contact with someone showing symptoms in the last 48 hours, or if you or a member of your household* is self-isolating.
6. Please use the hand sanitizer when entering this facility
7. For your own safety avoid touching your face/mouth/eyes
8. For the benefit of and respect for others, please leave this facility in a clean and tidy condition and, if possible, wipe clean surfaces that you have touched before you leave
9. We ask that you refrain from bringing pets/animals into the court
- 10.If you are playing tennis, please ensure that the net is lowered after your game
- 11.Please ensure the gate is properly closed when you leave
- 12.For your own safety please wash your hands and equipment when you return when you return to your vehicle and when you get home
